Ekaya is a not-for-profit organisation with over 30 years of experience providing housing and support services to predominately Black Minority Ethnic women and their families in South London. Our portfolio includes the provision of high-quality support to teenage mothers and their babies, as well as our award-winning children's community Nursery in Tulse Hill, Lambeth.

Based in Brixton, South London, we own and manage c. 500 homes, with a group turnover in excess of £6.6m in 2025/26. We have achieved Gold Investors in People accreditation, and our community Nursery is rated "good" by Ofsted.

Ekaya has an ambitious growth programme including a mixture of new developments, stock transfers and acquisitions. We will also develop our services to include supporting young parents and encouraging them to reach their potential, whether through finding jobs, internships or taking up further educational opportunities.

We are looking for two inspirational individuals with a broad range of skills to help shape our growing business and further develop our community and resident focus. We are looking for someone who is a qualified accountant with experience at senior level, (not necessarily within social housing) and someone with experience in the leadership and management of Early Years Education.

Ideally, we anticipate our new Board members joining us as soon as possible to allow time for induction and in advance of the Annual General Meeting 24/09/2026.

The minimum time commitment will be at least 30 hours per annum and although Board Members are not remunerated, they will in return receive comprehensive training and support to learn new skills. In addition, they will join a board of interesting people who have a range of knowledge and experience to share. More importantly, our Board members will be

making a real difference to our single-parent, predominantly BME families and, by extension, our local community. Reasonable expenses are also paid to Board members.

Ekaya was a Founding Partner of community interest company, Race Equality Matters and our Chief Executive is Chair of the Black and Minority Ethnic London Landlords. We hold a commitment to deliver services that embrace diversity, equality, inclusion and fairness and are keen to have a Board that includes people from a range of backgrounds and different life experiences.
